- 7. Any animals showing an open sore will be sent home immediately.
- 8. YOUTH ARE LIMITED TO TWO NON-OWNED ANIMAL PER SPECIES. COPY OF NON-OWNERSHIP PAPERS MUST BE FILED IN THE 4-H OFFICE WITH FAIR ENTRY.
- 9. NON-OWNERSHIP IS NOT AVAILABLE TO YOUTH ALREADY OWNING MEAT OR DAIRY GOATS.
